THE PROGRAM

The EU's *Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data*—referred to as the GDPR—goes into effect May 25, 2018. The GDPR is a sweeping data privacy law that not only affects European business; it also applies to any organization gathering data about individuals in the EU or directing commercial activities at them. This session will introduce and familiarize practitioners with the GDPR's key provisions, focusing on what triggers liability and the attendant consequences. The panel will discuss some of the GDPR's implications for eDiscovery in cases with international players.
